GIRARD EQUIPMENT DESIGNS FUEL OIL TRUCK TO COMMEMORATE 10-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF 9-11

Girard Equipment, USA announces that the company was commissioned by Arrow Fuel to design a fuel oil truck commemorating next year's 10th anniversary of 9-11. The vehicle, which specifically honors the brave passengers who perished on Flight 93, is also intended to raise awareness for two local charities, Tuesday's Children and the Vincent G. Halloran Fund for Children.

Inspired by the great acts of heroism that ensued after the heinous events of September 11, 2001, Arrow Fuel called upon Girard Equipment to custom-design a truck telling the remarkable story of human bravery that took place on that tragic day. The eye-catching mobile tribute lists the names of the 40 brave passengers who stopped their plane from reaching its intended target. Also memorialized are the passengers who perished on the other three hijacked flights – American Airlines Flight 11, American Airlines Flight 77 and United Airlines Flight 175.

"We decided to name the truck Flight 93 in honor of the first day we fought back," said Scott Monto of Arrow Fuel.

Flight 93 has already hit the road on its mission of raising awareness for these acts of bravery while simultaneously bringing attention to Tuesday's Children and the Vincent G. Halloran Fund for Children. As a family-owned business, the Girard Equipment team is happy to partner with these charities, both of which were established to serve the needs of children and families.

Vincent Halloran, a lieutenant of Ladder Company 8 in the Tribeca area of Manhattan, left behind five sons and his pregnant wife, Marie, when he was killed in the North Tower of the World Trade Center. Marie inspired the charitable effort in 2002 when her community approached her about hosting a golf event to raise money for her and her children.
